**COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND VOLUNTARY ACCEPTANCE OF RISK**

<b>1.</b>	<b>PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED PERSONS</b>
1.1.	<b>No person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (this includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue) is permitted to attend the Circuit or participate in the Event.</b>
1.2.	<b>Any person who starts to feel unwell or to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 during the Event must immediately avoid contact with all persons at the Circuit and MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE the Circuit.</b>
2.	<u>Note – The number chosen in 2.1 must not exceed the maximum number of people permitted to gather under State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations.</u> <b>SOCIAL DISTANCING AND DENSITY REQUIREMENTS</b>
2.1.	Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons are not permitted to gather in groups greater than Choose a number while in attendance at the Event. <b>(Delete if no limit on Group size by the State Government required)</b>
2.2.	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must always be observed.
2.3.	The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included in the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan.
2.4.	Food service provided at the Event must fully comply with all State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hand Hygiene must be available at all food service outlets.</li> <li>• Regular cleaning in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan MUST be carried out throughout the Event.</li> </ul>
<b>3.</b>	<b>Check In Requirements</b>
3.1	<b>All Attendees MUST complete and submit the Karting Australia COVID-19 Declaration, or the compulsory State Government issued QR Code Check-In (delete which is not relevant) upon arrival at the venue if required by the State or Federal Government.</b>
4.	<b>HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER</b>
4.1	The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained.
4.2	Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use.
4.3	Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned at least once during the day or as otherwise required in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan</li> </ul>
4.4	It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations in addition to hand sanitiser that is supplied by the Club.

<b>4.</b>	Heats & Final	Grid Procedure as per state regulations. Heat 1- Grid Positions in accordance with results of Qualifying – Fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on. Heat 2- Grid Positions in accordance with results of Qualifying – Fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on. Heat 3 - Highest Accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on pole position and so on. Final – Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on.

<b>Trophies and Prizes.</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place Trophies will be presented at the Meeting to all Senior and KA3 classes. 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> place Trophies will be given to the Cadet 9 and Cadet 12 classes and the KA4 junior Light and Heavy classes. Final only counts for Trophies on the day.
	All points count towards the series – 401 points system will be used. DSQ and DNS= Zero points. Non Starters will be awarded zero points. Non Finishers (DNF) will be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed. In instance of this will be followed by the grid position awarded from the start of a heat. DSQ will not be awarded any points. In the event of a tie on points, the lower grid position will be awarded to the driver with the faster original qualifying time.

<b>3.</b>	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>

3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the In Grid and Out Grid Gates only.
4.	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	No Cars to be parked in the Pit area.
4.7.	Officials and Canteen Staff <b>ONLY</b> permitted to park behind the canteen.
4.8.	No open fires or fires of any sort are to be lit on the club premises.
