





ORGANISED SOCIAL KARTING SESSIONS SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS V1 (Effective Date 1 January 2022)

Important Notes

- 1. These Supplementary Regulations can only be used for Organised Social Karting activities at an Affiliated Club in accordance with all Federal and/or State Government COVID-19 Public Health Orders, Restrictions and Directions ("Government Orders").
- 2. The Organiser must advise the SKA of any adjustment to the listed Officials for a Social Karting Activity by completing and submitting the on-line Social Karting Activity Notification Form prior to the start of the Karting Activity.

COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND VOLUNTARY ACCEPTANCE OF RISK

By entering or participating in this Karting activity/event, all Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons acknowledge that, even with rigorous capacity and control measures that Karting Australia requires the Organising Club to put in place at all Karting Australia sanctioned Karting activities/events, there remains an unquantifiable risk of transmission of viral illness including COVID-19 at a Karting activity/event at this time and you have considered that risk and your own personal circumstances, including any health condition or vulnerability that you may have or that of persons whom you will be in close contact with following your attendance at a Karting activity/event. 4.3	Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels. The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned at least once during the day or as otherwise required in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan	
4.4	• It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations in addition to hand sanitiser that is supplied by the Club.

1.2.	2. Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Grid / Track Control Official.			
1.3.	A person must only enter the Track when permitted by an Official and then only when safe to do so.

2.1.	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.			
2.2.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
