3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via OUT GRID/IN GRID only Trolley crew MUST have permission from an official before entering the circuit.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, R/C vehicles, skateboards or tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Footballs, soccerballs, tennis balls and other similar objects are not to be kicked/thrown anywhere near a live kart track. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	All pit shades to be secured
4.7.	Camping is permitted in designated areas
4.8.	No fires of any description permitted, fire restrictions in force. Offenders maybe removed from meeting.
4.9.	No Cars in pit/paddock area
4.10.	Officials and Canteen staff only are permitted to park behind canteen, offenders' vehicles will be removed
