6.1.	8 is the minimum number of pre-entries which must be received for each Class and/or Division.	
6.2.	If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.	
6.3.	If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

2.	Practice	2 Practice sessions of 6 minutes for each class will be held. the order of grid positions will be allocated. The second practice session will be timed for qualifying positions. Transponders must be fitted for all practices.				
3.	Qualifying	There will be Timed Qualifying at this Event. There will be one (1) standalone Qualifying session of 6 minutes . Qualifying positions will be from the second timed practice results.				
4.	Heats & Final	The system of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations - Series Competition Format 2 Heat 1 and heat 2: Grid Positions in accordance with the results of Qualifying, - fastest Driver on Pole Position and so on. Heat 3: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1 and Heat 2 will start on Pole Position and so on. Final: Highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2, and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on.

Only in exceptional circumstances and then only with the approval of the Stewards will it be permitted for a Driver who has qualified for an award not to attend the Trophy Presentation. Failure to attend the Trophy Presentation and remain correctly attired until it has concluded will be considered a breach of the Rules.</p> <p>Clubs are to ensure that competitors are in their race suit for presentation.</p>

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via in/out grid – with the guidance of race officials
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	<p>in accordance with the 2023 Victorian State regulations cameras are compulsory and are to be fitted from first practice session</p> <p>It is compulsory for all Competitors to fit a camera to their Kart in a working condition from the start of the first practice session at each Meeting. Failure to do so will result in Disqualification of the Competitor from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final practice session of the day the Competitor will start from the rear of the grid in qualifying.</p> <p>b) A separate SD Card must be used for each Class contested at a Meeting.</p> <p>c) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.</p> <p>d) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.</p>
