4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.

4.4.	No motorized scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
