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

| 3. | KART RETRIEVAL |
| 3.1. | Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing. |
| 3.2. | Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course |
| 3.3. | Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the Upper torso. |
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| 3.4. | Karts can be retrieved via the out grid – with the guidance of race officials |
| 4. | ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS |
| 4.1. | Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility. |
| 4.2. | No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements. |
| 4.3. | No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit. |
| 4.4. | No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting. |
| | <p>SERIES POINT SCORE</p> <p>The Series does publish Series point score updates after each round.</p> <p>a) A Driver must compete in a Class or Division at all six (6) Rounds of the Series to be eligible for overall Series Trophies.</p> <p>b) The Series classification in each Class or Division will be based on the Competitor with the highest accumulated points of all Rounds in the Series. For the avoidance of doubt, a competitor does not need to compete in all rounds of the Series to be eligible for the series awards.</p> <p>c) A Driver must compete in six (6) Rounds of the Series in any Class or Division to be eligible for the end of year lucky draw prizes.</p> <p>i) Lucky draw prizes must be claimed on the Saturday Night Draw at the final Round of the Series.</p> <p>ii) Drivers MUST be in attendance to claim prize.</p> <p>iii) In the event of there being unclaimed prizes after the initial prize draw, these prizes will be redrawn until all prizes have been claimed.</p> <p>The Series presentations will take place at the Karting Victoria Presentation night</p> |
