3.	KART RETRIEVAL	
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.	
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course	
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso	
	can be retrieved via the Out Grid.	
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4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, tricycles or remote-controlled vehicles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	The availability or not, of camping at the circuit will be advised via the VCS social media.
4.6.	Officials and Canteen staff only are permitted to park behind canteen, offender's vehicles will be removed. All other vehicles are to be removed from the pits for the duration of the timetable. Parking is available outside of the venue.
4.7.	Generators to be turned off no later than 9.30 pm each night while at the circuit.
