Albury Wodonga Kart Racing Club – January 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> January 2026

The following Division is eligible to compete in Ladies Pink Plate Event.

- Ladies Masters
  - This Division is in accordance with the TaG 125 Restricted Class Rules – Chapter 12 and KA3 Class Rules – Chapter 6 with the only amendments being the Minimum weights for the Ladies Masters Division which are as follows:
- Licence Requirements
  - Must hold a Maximum B Grade Senior Licence
- Licence Age
  - Must be a minimum of 35 years of age
- Minimum weight including the Driver:
  - IAME KA100 165kg
  - All other engines 172 kg
- Rotax engines can run the SR2 restrictor, all other engines to run their book class restrictor.

Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee will be refunded in accordance with the Rules.

In lieu of an administration checking session, an Official Entry List including class, race numbers and transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of Friday, 23 January 2026 It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. ### Trackside Assistants

Allocation of Trackside Assistants Will occur for the Meeting for Cadet 9, Cadet 12 and KA3 Junior Light & Heavy in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 12.

The Trackside Assistants are required, when safe to do so, to assist any Driver to remove their kart/s from an unsafe position in the event of an on-track incident or breakdown. **Under no circumstances should a Trackside Assistant be filming or taking photographs during a Warm-up lap, Formation lap or the Race.**

### Pit Crew/Participant Licence

Any persons who seek or require access to the circuit, the in grid, the out grid, scrutineering and parc ferme areas must hold either a current Pit Crew/Drivers licence or a Participation licence if the driver is a minor.

### Protest Fees

There Will be credit card facilities available to enable the processing of protest fees.

## CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

### Kart Retrieval

Pit Crew with trolleys Will be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing. If permitted, retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Karts can be retrieved via Outgrid or gate at turn 4

### Temporary Facilities/Structures

All Structures must only be erected in areas approved by the Organiser in accordance with General Rules Chapter 4, Rules 21 (*the "TFS Rules"*)

All Structures must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules

Type A Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules are permitted to be erected at this Meeting.

Type B Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (*floor plan between 18 sqm and 36sq*) Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.

Type C Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (*floor plan more than 36sq*) Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.

### Camping

Ability for people to stay overnight at the Venue Will be permitted.

### Additional Venue Requirements

**Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, animals Will Not be allowed within the facility.**

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
